In this series of microfilming church records (as permitted) held by the Archives Authority of N.S.W., it was felt that the only logical method was to follow the numerical sequence of the Archives Office's accession numbers.

This was followed for the volumes filmed for SAG reels 0101-0106. With the filming of records as found in reels 0128-0135, we went forward to the earlier registers of the Wesleyan and Methodist baptisms and filmed to the end of the permitted volumes. This series continued the filming where reel 0106 ended. The filming will continue.

In these series, generally the ministers of the Wesleyan and Methodist Circuits have not been named. There are well kept records of the Wesleyan and Methodist ministers in the Circuit lists held by the Uniting Church Archives. However, the ministers of the Presbyterian and Congregational Churches did tend to go outside their main parish to celebrate marriages and would take their registers with them. Therefore, an alphabetical list of these ministers is useful to those who use the reels. There is a similar listing of the Congregational, Presbyterian and Primitive Methodist ministers to go with reels 0101-0106. This does not, however, show the same chronological sequence as given above.

When these records were held by the Register General, they were in many cases bound together into volumes without any apparent sequence, all and any denominations together. Hence the filming in the numerical accessions sequence and the accompanying lists of ministers.

A previously compiled, in particular by Mrs L. M. MacDonald, shelf listing of the pertinent Archives held registers of the Uniting Church and Presbyterian Church is of continuing invaluable help in the processing for microfilming of these records.
