Holy Trinity Anglican Church Kameruka, N.S.W.

From Ransome T Wyatt's *History of the Diocese of Goulburn*, 1937 (SAG Library B4.580/91/1)

There is evidence of ministrations to the area as early as 1846 and 1855. In 1864 Kameruka became part of the charge of Bega-Pambula-Eden. In 1879 Kameruka became part an independent parish from Bega which still included Eden and Pambula.

Holy Trinity Church was built in 1869 when Kameruka was still part of the parish of Bega.

St. Paul's Anglican Church Koorawatha, N.S.W.

In 1911 the parish of Koorawatha was formed from parts of the parishes of Boorawa and Young. (R.T. Wyatt: History of the Diocese of Goulburn, 1937)

St. John's Anglican Church Lake Bathurst, N.S.W.

This parish was formally known as Tarago. At First, Revd. Thomas Hassall's charge covered the area; from 1833 Revd. John Vincent of Sutton Forest was regularly visiting Goulburn and if need be, Tarago (Lake Bathurst). From 1838-1877 Lake Bathurst was in the parish of Collector, except when occasionally served from Goulburn & Bungonia. In 1877 the parish of Tarago was formed and in 1896 the name changed to Lake Bathurst. In 1859 the church of St John was built. St Andrew's Church, Tarago was licensed in 1893. (R.T. ANGLICAN PARISH OF MARULAN, N.S.W.

Mr R. T. Wyatt wrote in 1837 that the present parish of Marulan was only formed in 1888, from the parish of Bungonia (1840) and the earlier parish of Marulan (1870).

Services in the area from Bungonia to Marulan were probably held by Revd. Thomas Hassall and Revd. John Vincent. In 1838 Revd. William Sowerby was appointed to Goulburn & Bungonia; in 1840 Revd. G. N. Woodd was appointed to the charge of Bungonia with Jacqua and Marulan. Later the parish was known as Bungonia with Marulan. From 1870-1875 Marulan was served by Goulburn, North Goulburn, West Goulburn & Taralga. In 1888 Bungonia was absorbed into the parish of Marulan after being equal parishes for some 18 years. (History of the Goulburn Diocese)
