## Wesleyan Methodist: Wagga Wagga Circuit

- Marriages 30<sup>th</sup> August 1864 – 10<sup>th</sup> December 1879 219-256A  
At Wesley Churches at Wagga Wagga. Also private residences including some at Hanging Rock, Wagga Wagga, 15 Mile Water Hole, Bullenborg, Swampy Plains, Lake Albert, Euranquilty, Junee, Upper Tarcutta, Junee Reefs, Urana.
